




How to present the assignment

- 1. The main note of the key of the assignment will be indicated by a piano tone before the first performance.
- 2. Each of the five times it is played is preceded by a short signal tone; the first time there is one signal tone, and the fifth time, in turn, begins after the five signal tones.
- 3. Chords and basses will be played by Strings or Horns and Strings sound, and melodies will be played by Strings, woodwinds, brass sound or etc..
- 4. The time signature is not given, so the answer may be 2 bars or 8 bars, not necessarily 4 bars.
- 5. When answering with harmonic symbols, VI, II, etc. can be indicated as VIm, IIm. There is no need to indicate inversions (I², II¹, GonC, etc.).



How to present the assignment

- 1. The main note of the key of the assignment will be indicated by a piano tone before the first performance.
- 2. The signal for the start of the performance is the same for the seven times in total, unlike Grades 5 and 4.
- 3. Chords and basses will be played by Strings or Horns and Strings sound, and melodies will be played by Strings, woodwinds, brass sound or etc..
- 4. The time signature is not given, so the answer may be 2 bars or 8 bars, not necessarily 4 bars.
- 5. When answering with harmonic symbols, VI, II, etc. can be indicated as VIm, IIm. There is no need to indicate inversions (I², II¹, GonC, etc.).
- 6. In the case of harmonic symbols, there are many ways to indicate various chord changes. Therefore, in Grade 3, it is recommended that you use chord names if possible.
